TVAS Landscaping Committee Snow Removal Policy

- 1. Members of the Landscaping Committee (LC) will rotate coverage on a monthly basis to supervise the snow removal contractor services from November through March.
- 2. In October of each year the Landscaping Committee will submit to the snow-removal contractor a list of committee members which will include:
 - a. Names and phone numbers of (LC) members to be contacted by contractor
 - b. The schedule of dates that contacts will be covering
- 3. If the scheduled (LC) member or the contractor deems it necessary they will communicate before, during, and after an inclement weather event to discuss conditions and actions. They will also perform a visual inspection of the road conditions after treatment to further access if any other treatment may be necessary.
- 4. Per the snow removal contract, snow plowing and treatment will begin when snowfall accumulates to 2 inches.
- Ice formation on streets will be treated with salt, pre-treatment (if available) or cinders and plowing as deemed necessary by the contractor or recommended by the LC member.
- 6. Per rule # 37, unit owner vehicles, guest vehicles, and visitor's vehicles are required to move all vehicles off the street during snow/ice storms. It is the sole responsibility of unit owners to be aware of inclement weather forecasts and act accordingly.
